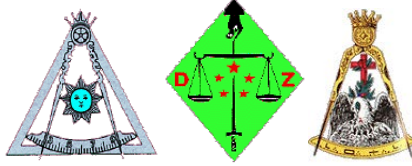


SCOTTISH RITE BODIES NEWSLETTER
